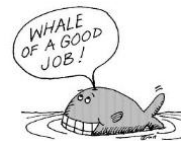

ATTENTION, PARENTS!

This summer, in late July or early August, an important mailing will be headed your way. Included will be homeroom assignments and other information regarding the upcoming 2022-2023 school year. Please make sure the school office has your current mailing information on file. Be on the lookout for your envelope!

GET READY FOR THIS FALL BY...

- If your child has had their physical this year, please make sure to send the completed physical form in to the office.
- If your child needs to have a physical make sure to bring the physical form with you to the appointment. Send the completed form to the school. Remember, both sides of the form need to be completed. Side one – Part B – is for the doctor to complete and side two – Part A – is for the parent to complete.
- All students will receive the *Annual Health Update* and *Parental Consent to Participate in Sports* forms on the first day of school. Once these papers have been turned in along with the physical (if needed) you will be all set to try out for sports programs.
- Sports programs begin shortly after school starts so it's important to make sure you have all the paperwork complete and turned in at the office or you **will not** be able to tryout or participate.
- **Has your mailing address changed? Have you had a name change? Has your email address changed?** Please make sure we have your current mailing

address (if you have a PO Box we also need your **physical address for busing purposes**), your current phone numbers, correct email address, and any name changes.

- An important information document is going home during the summer so now is a good time to update your information.

CHEFS FOOD PANTRY



CHEFS is open to residents of Clifton, Holden, and Eddington. The pantry is open all year, every Thursday from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m. and the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month from 9:00 to 10:00 a.m.

CHEFS accepts donations of non-perishable items all year long. Staple items we like to keep on hand are: peanut butter, canned meat (tuna, chicken, etc.), canned pasta (ravioli, spaghetti-o's, etc.), canned vegetables, canned fruit, soup, boxed pasta, cans or jars of spaghetti sauce, and toilet tissue. Donations may be dropped off at the school (in the entryway near the Superintendent's office) whenever the school is open, including the summer months.
