The RSU #63 Board of Directors (the Board) hereby adopts the System of Learning Results and the Maine Department of Education's applicable rules. The Learning Results System is intended to serve as a foundation for education to promote and provide assessment of school learning, accountability, and equity. The Board recognizes that the legislative intent of the Learning Results System is to provide children with education that reflects high expectations and creates conditions where these expectations can be met.

- I. Implementation of the Learning Results System has broad implications for RSU #63 (the District) including curriculum, budget, professional development, student assessment, professional evaluation, and promotion requirements. The Board is committed to examining policies to ensure they are consistent with the intent and goals of the Learning Results System.
